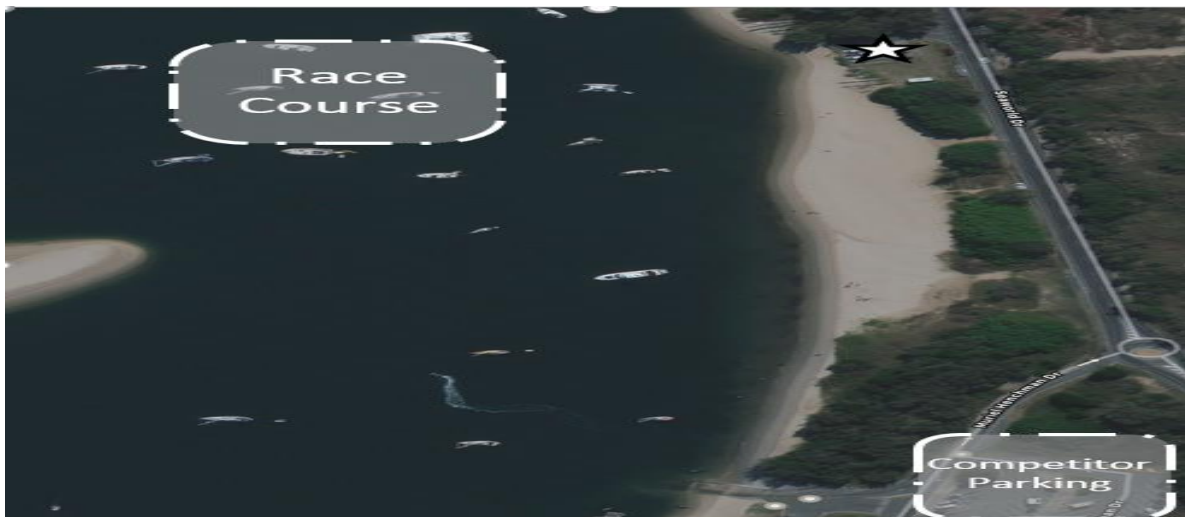
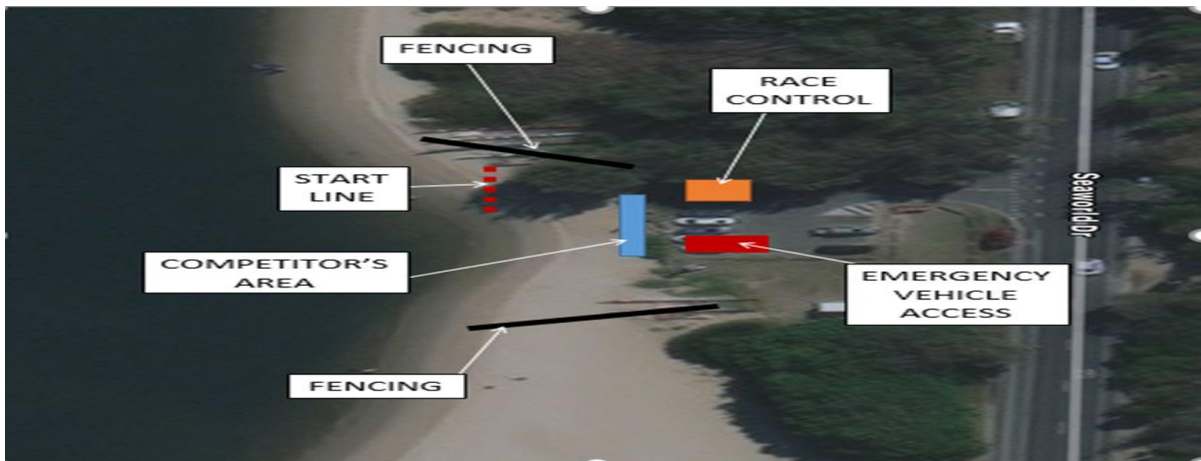
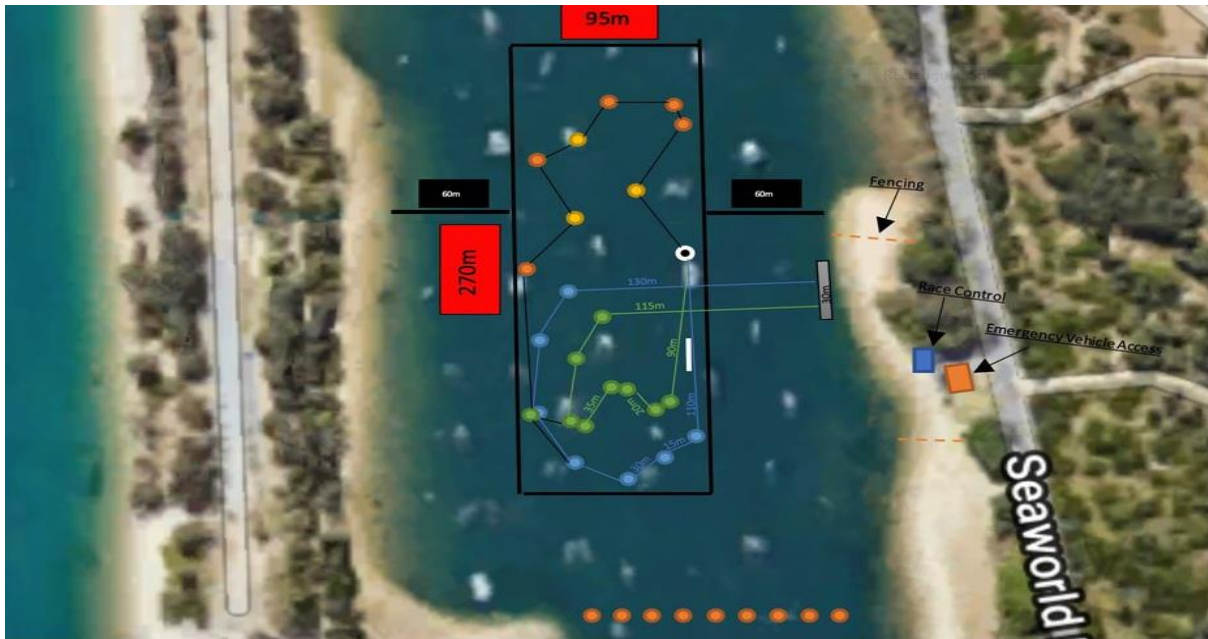

Event Information

- During the event, competitors will launch their PWCs at the Boat ramps located at Muriel Henschman drive. This will occur early on both days by 7 30am. All competitor PWCs will then remain within the Competitors Staging area for the day. This is to minimise the passage of watercraft between the busy boat ramps and the track area.
- Competitors can park their vehicles and trailers in the parking area adjacent to the boat ramps.
- In the small parking area off Seaworld Drive adjacent to the track, an area will be set up for Race control, Fuel storage and emergency services access lane. Competitors can set up shade tents along the beach area within the fenced area.
- **Competitors must pre-register online and pay before December 10th.** There are no entries or payment on the day.

- Competitors and pit crew are reminded of the high standard of behaviour required as per the AJSBA code of conduct. Bad Behaviour and failure to adhere to the AJSBAs code of conduct during this event will not be tolerated.
- **Please note all competitors must provide a Go Pro or similar recording camera and 2 SD cards to wear on their person or PWC.** Please mark on the scrutineering form if you will provide your own or need to loan a unit.
- **The Shoreline EX Challenge** will be run on both days as a hot lap competition. The event will be split between the Novice and Pro am class with Prize Money and Prizes awarded to the overall fastest time.
- **A GP1 Hot lap Challenge** will also be held during the event with riders selected from the top placings in the Ski Divisions at the end of Saturday.
